

# Sample Breed Specific Parameters: Mythical Rarehund

*Approved by the Mythical Rarehund Club of America August 2024*

## *Acceptance Supplemental Questions (Stud Dog)*

The following sections summarize the supplemental questions for screening established by the Mythical Rarehund Club of America for potential donations of frozen semen from any Mythical Rarehund dog to the AKC Purebred Preservation Bank (AKC PPB).

The following information should be provided for any dog whose semen is being donated to the AKC PPB:

### General Information

\*Color and Pattern (Only colors and patterns allowed by the breed standard may be distributed for breeding purposes. Alternate or non-standard colors or patterns may be accepted, but may only be used for research purposes).

\*Coat type.

\*Age and cause of death if deceased.

### Health

\* Donors will be required to provide date of brucellosis test in Dog Information (must be within 30 days prior to any collections after 1/1/2024).

\*Breed specific health testing should include all Parent Club recommended health testing at the time of collection.

\*Donations from dogs that have a history of the following should not be accepted: dilated cardiomyopathy, deafness, hereditary or epilepsy related seizures, or crippling life-threatening disease.

### Breeding History

\*Number of males produced and number of females produced should be included in information for each litter the dog produced.

\*Number of progeny with disqualifying faults or non-standard colors or patterns

\*Health and temperament traits of offspring.

\*Conformation and/or performance titles for offspring.

## *Distribution Criteria (Bitch)*

The following sections summarize the screening criteria established by the Mythical Rarehund Club of America for potential distribution of frozen semen to any Mythical Rarehund bitch for breeding purposes.

The following information must be provided for any bitch to be bred using frozen semen to be distributed from the AKC PPB:

### General Information

\*Date of birth: the bitch must be at least two (2) years old, and may not be older than seven 7 years old.

\* Color and Pattern (Only colors and patterns allowed by the breed standard should be bred. Bitches of alternate or non-standard colors may not be bred using frozen semen from the AKC PPB).

### Health

\*Breed specific health testing should include all current Parent Club recommended health testing. Documentation of the results will be required before distribution for breeding will be considered.

\*Any available medical records for the bitch should also be supplied. Bitches that have a history of the following may not be bred: dilated cardiomyopathy, deafness, hereditary or epilepsy related seizures or crippling life-threatening disease.

\*Brucellosis tested within two months prior to breeding with a negative result.

### Breeding History

\*Information on the breeding history of the bitch is also important. The bitch must be proven and have successfully whelped at least one (1) litter. Additionally, the bitch may not be used if she has previously whelped four (4) or more litters.

\*Number of progeny with disqualifying faults or non-standard colors or patterns

\*Health and temperament traits of offspring produced by the bitch should be provided.

### Breeder Requirements

\*Has successfully bred one (1) or more litters of Mythical Rarehunds that were registered with AKC or an AKC registration eligible foreign registry.

\*Is a current member of the Mythical Rarehund Club of America, or is an AKC Breeder of Merit.

\*Has finished at least two AKC Champions or Performance titles

\*Agrees to the Mythical Rarehund Club of America's Code of Ethics.

\*Agrees to share disposition and results of litter produced with AKC PPB and the Mythical Rarehund Club of America

\*Agrees to only use frozen semen on a naturally occurring, not drug-induced estrous cycle.

\*Agrees to document the proposed breeding, and will be either surgical implant or a transcervical implant performed by a licensed veterinarian experienced in canine reproduction.
